
FY 2022 Budget Instructions

- Provided by the Office of Planning and Budget (Augusth)
- FY 2022- USG permitted to request workload increases for growth in enrollment, increases in square footage and health insurance changes through the funding formula
- FY 2021 Amended Agencies directed to submit flat budgets equivalent to current FY 2021 appropriation—no changes to the current budget
