Note: Beginning with this issue of the SER, the definition of Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrollment on page 1 has changed. The new FTE calculation will sum undergraduate and graduate FTE. Undergraduate FTE will be calculated by counting each undergraduate student enrolled for at least 12 hours and then adding to that the number derived by dividing all hours enrolled by part-time undergraduate students by 12. Graduate FTE is the number of graduate or professional students enrolled for at least 9 hours plus the number derived by dividing all hours enrolled by part-time graduate or professional students by 9.
